The ownership transfer is made in accordance with the following terms of
sale:

HEALTH GUARANTEE

You have purchased a puppy bred only after careful consideration of the
compatibility of the parents based on the physical structure, designated
use, mental ability, and pedigree. We would never knowingly sell any
puppy with a genetic defect or that is not in good health or that has poor
temperament.

- A. If a veterinarian certifies the puppy to be ill or possessing a genetic
defect within 7 days after purchase, the puppy will be replaced or a
full refund will be given.
- B. Your puppy was immunized when it was 8 weeks old. We
recommend your puppy be re-immunized according to your
veterinarian's recommended schedule and annually thereafter. You
should talk to your veterinarian about this schedule, and ask for his
recommendation. **UNTIL YOUR PUPPY HAS HAD ALL ITS
IMMUNIZATIONS PLEASE BE CAREFUL ABOUT EXPOSING HIM/HER
TO OTHER DOGS OR TO AREAS WHERE OTHER DOGS FREQUENT.**
Please discuss this issue with your veterinarian.
- C. Your puppy was wormed at 2, 3, 4, 6, and 8 weeks of age.

HIP AND EYE GURANTEE

Hip dysplasia, DM and PRA are problems found in Chesapeake Bay Retrievers. Hip dysplasia is approximately 50% hereditary and 50% environmentally induced. We will however, refund purchase price or replace any puppy or dog that has hip dysplasia, PRA, or DM provided:

- A. The breeders sold the puppy to the owner of record.**
- B. The dog must be x-rayed and evaluated by the OFA and the examination performed between the ages of 2 and 3 years.**
- C. The breeders must receive a letter or proof of unsoundness from the veterinarian who examined the dog.**
- D. The dog MUST NOT have been used for breeding. If the dog was used for breeding before these examinations were done, the guarantee is void.**
- E. The guarantee for hips is void if the puppy has been exercised in excess. We encourage free-play and retrieving on soft ground, but too much exercise can be detrimental to developing muscles and joints. No jumping such as Frisbee playing, jumping in and out of trucks, or jumping/running on hard surfaces should take place during the growth period.**
- F. The buyer must pay the difference between the initial purchase price and the price of the replacement puppy if greater.**
- G. If an unsound dog is replaced by the seller, any shipping charges are to be paid by the buyer**

EMERGENCY PLACEMENT OF THE PUPPY/ADULT DOG

We strive to ensure that a puppy is being purchased from our kennel only after careful consideration and research by the purchaser, and that the purchaser has the time and provides the environment to raise the puppy properly. We accept all responsibility as conscientious breeders to place our puppies in excellent homes. We NEVER want any of our dogs to be placed in an animal shelter, rescue organization, or an unsuitable home.

- A. If purchaser cannot continue to keep the puppy/adult, we MUST be notified.**
- B. In emergency situations: We, the breeders, agree to accept the dog back. There will be no refund of the purchase price. The AKC papers are to be transferred back to us and we will assume full responsibility for appropriate care for the dog.**

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. "Courage, desire to please, and loyalty":** These are the things you will give your puppy/adult through its day-to-day experiences with life. Life expands far beyond your backyard. Allow your dog to be confident (with your gentle guidance). Confidence will never come through your dominance. If you dominate him/her as a puppy, you will never build courage or loyalty, and could ruin your dog's natural working abilities and desire to please. We do however, expect you to discipline your dog, and enforce the learning of everyday manners.

- B. You will provide safe and sensible confinement for your puppy/adult during the times you cannot supervise its activities.**

- C. If you have purchased a female puppy, you need to be especially aware of her needs when she is in season. You will have to be extremely careful of what kind of confinement you provide for her during this time, and be careful not to leave her unattended if there is any possibility she could come in contact with a male dog. (This includes when she is in a fenced area or even in a crate.)**

- D. We emphasize that your puppy was bred for its intelligence. Teach your puppy to love learning--this is the secret to anything you wish to do with your dog now and in the future, including being a welcome member of your family.**
